




II. Installation


Read the following topics and perform the procedures in the correct order. Incorrect installation may cause damage to the product.

II-1. Physically Setup

There are three ways to physically set up the switch. No matter how you installed the switch, please keep it with good ventilation.


- 1. **Desktop Placement**: Attach the supplied rubber feet to the recessed areas on the bottom of the switch. Place the switch on a flat surface and keep it with good ventilation.
- **2. Wall-Mount Installation**: The product is designed with wall-mounted holes. The wall-mounted mounting screws and accessories are not included.
- 3. Rack-Mount Installation: You can mount the switch in any standard size, 19-inch (about 48 cm) wide rack with 1 Rack Unit (1U) of space, which is 1.75 inches (4.45 cm) high. First, to align the mounting brackets with the mounting holes on the switch's side panels and secure the brackets with the screws. Then secure the switch on the equipment rack.





II-2. Connection

- 1. **Power on**: Connect the power cord to the switch and the power outlet. (Note: Make sure that the "PWR" LED is green.)
- 2. **Uplink**: Plug the standard Cat5e (or Above) Ethernet cable into the LAN port and uplink to a switch or router. (Note: Make sure that the "LAN" LED is green or amber.)
- 3. **Connect devices**: Plug the standard Cat5e (or Above) Ethernet cable into the LAN port and connect to any networking device with an Ethernet port. (Note: Make sure that the "LAN" LED is green or amber.) The installation is complete!
